We're even reconfiguring our stage so you can sit at the centre of the action (if you wish) for this very special play set in and around our wonderful city.

No Exeter Christmas would be complete without our award-nominated pantomime, created once again with local favourites **Le Navet Bete**. This year, bring your family and friends to the ball, as we present *Cinderella*, the most beloved story of them all. And for the first time, we're also staging a unique 'no kids allowed' performance, with a bit of extra naughtiness only for the grown-ups.

For younger children, the Barnfield Theatre plays host to a brand-new version of *The Elves and the Shoemaker*, co-produced by the Northcott and the brilliant **Paddleboat Theatre Company**.

If new plays and fresh ideas are your cup of tea, look out for our Elevate Festival in October; a whole week celebrating local theatre-makers with a variety of shows, scratch performances and workshops. We've also got Reclaim Festival to look forward to in November; a six-day programme of shows, talks and workshops made by women for women, curated by **Katy Danbury** and **Naomi Turner**.

Last but not least, we will once again welcome the very best shows and celebrities to Exeter, including **Katherine Ryan**, **Mo Gilligan**, **English Touring Opera**, **Jasmin Vardimon Company**, and the return of the hugely popular *Black Is the Color of My Voice*.

There are also many other ways to get involved, including a wide range of classes and courses, eight youth theatre groups, special ticket schemes and more.

Autumn/Winter 2024 is a big season for Exeter's wonderful theatres, and we very much look forward to welcoming you all.

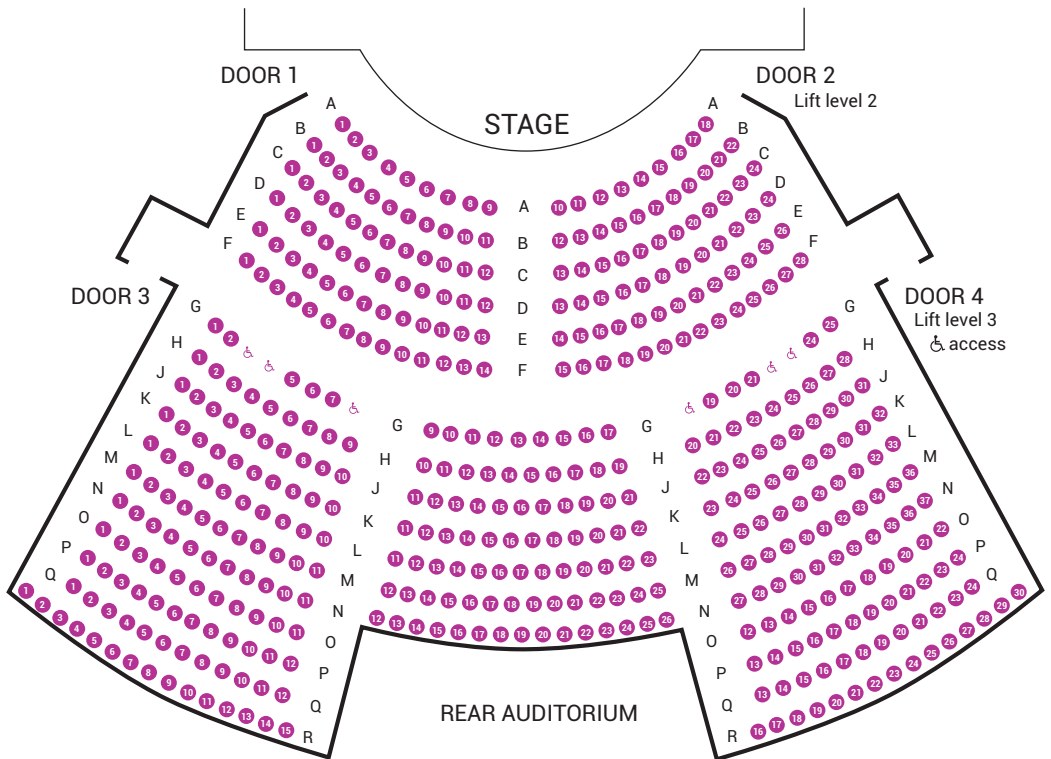
GETTING TO THE NORTHCOTT THEATRE

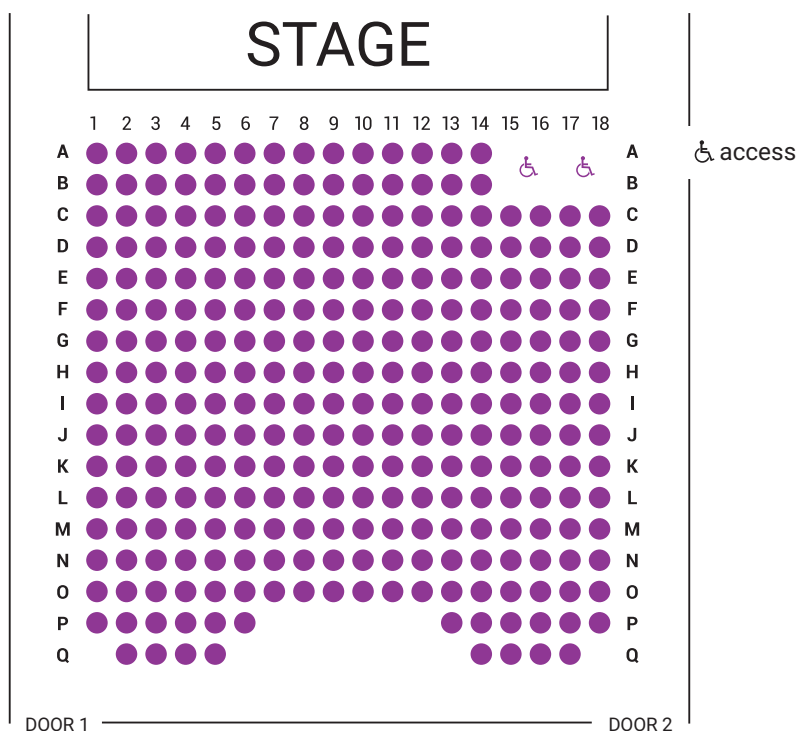

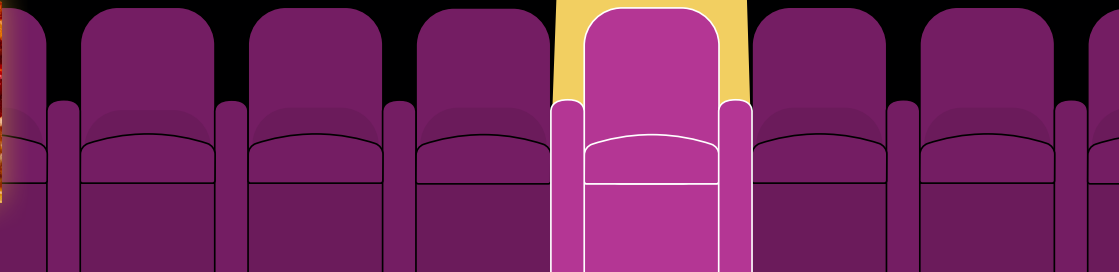
